Achievements and performance

During the year WCVA has continued to implement the Partnership Agreement, through which the Welsh Assembly Government funds the support services for the sector at national and local levels. WCVA has worked with county voluntary councils and volunteer centres to plan complementary services, underpinned by comprehensive training and information frameworks, identifying who does what to meet the needs of the sector at national, regional and local levels.

WCVA assesses its effectiveness by monitoring take-up of its services, levels of satisfaction with its services, the extent of its engagement with the sector, achievement of target dates, extent of the sector's engagement with public bodies, and the extent to which public policy takes account of the sector's interests. Yn ystod y flwyddyn hon, mae wedi parhau i weithredu'r Cytundeb Partneriaeth, sef y Cytundeb y mae Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru yn ei ddefnyddio i gyllido'r gwasanaethau cefnogi ar gyfer y sector ar lefel genedlaethol a lleol. Mae WCVA wedi gweithio gyda chynghorau gwirfoddol sirol a chanolfannau gwirfoddoli i gynllunio gwasanaethau ategol, a'r rheini'n seiliedig ar fframweithiau gwybodaeth a hyfforddiant cynhwysfawr, sy'n nodi pwysyn gwneud beth i ddiwallu anghenion y sector yn genedlaethol, yn rhanbarthol ac yn lleol.

Mae WCVA yn asesu ei effeithiolrwydd drwy fonitro'r canlynol: y niferoedd sy'n manteisio ar ei wasanaethau, pa mor fodlon yw pobl gyda'i wasanaethau, i ba raddau y mae'n ymgysylltu â'r sector, ei lwyddiant o ran cwblhau gwaith erbyn dyddiadau targed, i ba raddau y mae'r sector yn ymgysylltu â chyrff cyhoeddus, ac i ba raddau y mae polisi cyhoeddus yn rhoi sylw i fuddiannau'r sector. 1 Services for the sector

Gwasanaethau ar gyfer y sector

Volunteering

WCVA has maintained its work as the strategic lead body for volunteering in Wales. It has advocated policies that benefit volunteers, raised the public profile of volunteering, helped people access volunteering opportunities, and helped to raise standards in managing volunteers. It has provided funding for projects involving volunteers. Achievements this year include:

- Attracting over 52,000 visitors to the working with volunteers website.
- Maintaining and developing, with volunteer centres, a suite of volunteering information sheets on working with volunteers – the one called 'Thinking about volunteering' is the second most downloaded information sheet, with over 6,000 downloads.
- Retaining the Volunteering Wales website position as the top volunteering website on Google when searching for 'volunteer in Wales', advertising over 6,000 volunteering opportunities and attracting over 650,000 visitors.
- Promoting good practice in the management of volunteers through the Investing in Volunteers programme.
- Organising a national volunteering awards scheme which received 215 nominations.
- Providing access to criminal records checks for volunteers and staff of voluntary organisations, handling over 22,000 disclosure requests.
- Recruiting nearly 1,500 young people to the Millennium Volunteers programme and over 2,200 to the Russell Commission programme.

Gwirfoddoli

Mae WCVA yn parhau i weithio fel y prif gorff strategol dros gwirfoddoli yng Nghymru. Mae wedi pwysu am bolisiau sydd o fudd i gwirfoddolwyr, codi proffil gwirfoddoli ymhlihd y cyhoedd, helpu pobl i fanteisio ar gylleoedd gwirfoddol a helpu i godi safonau o ran rheoli gwirfoddolwyr. Mae wedi darparu cyllid ar gyfer prosiectau sy'n cynnwys gwirfoddolwyr. Dyma rai o'r pethau y mae wedi'u cyflawni eleni:

- Denu dros 52,000 o ymwelwyr i wefan gweithio gyda gwirfoddolwyr.
- Ar y cyd â chanolfannau gwirfoddoli, datblygu a chynnal cyfres o daflen ywbaeth am weithio gyda gwirfoddolwyr; llwythwyd y daflen 'Meddwl am gwirfoddoli' i lawr dros 6,000 o weithiau, sy'n golygu mai hon yw'r ail daflen ywbaeth fwyaf poblogaidd.
- Sicrhau bod gwefan Gwirfoddoli Cymru yn aros ar y brig fel y brif wefan gwirfoddoli sy'n ymddangos ar Google pan fydd rhywun yn chwilio am 'gwirfoddoli yng Nghymru'; hysbysebodd y wefan hon dros 6,000 o gylleoedd gwirfoddoli a denu dros 650,000 o ymwelwyr.
- Hybu arferion da yng nghyswilt rheoli gwirfoddolwyr drwy'r rhaglen Buddsoddi mewn Gwirfoddolwyr.
- Trefnu cynllun cenedlaethol i wobrwo ywbaethol a dderbyniodd 215 o enwebiadau.
- Sicrhau mynediad at archwiliadau cofnodion troseddol ar gyfer gwirfoddolwyr a staff mewn mudiadau gwirfoddol, gan ymdrin â dros 22,000 o geisiadau am archwiliadau datgelu.

- Funding projects involving over 6,800 volunteers through the Volunteering in Wales Fund and Active Community Initiative.

Trustees and governance

WCVA has continued to offer services to support trustees, including:

- Responding to over 500 trustee enquiries.
- Developing the trustee website, attracting over 30,000 visits with over 35,000 information downloads.
- Organising a national trustee conference attracting over 110 participants.
- Organising a charity law conference attracting over 90 participants.
- Providing a monthly e-bulletin for individual trustees, with over 580 recipients.

Funding

- Responding to over 3,400 helpline funding enquiries, and providing more detailed advice to over 280 organisations on European and other funding.
- Maintaining the Sustainable Funding Cymru website – www.sustainablefundingcymru.org.uk – this continues to be a popular resource for information on funding and finance options attracting over 36,000 visitors.
- Developing, with CVCs, a suite of 35 funding information sheets with six of the 'finding and getting money' series of information sheets featured in the top 10

Mae WCVA wedi parhau i gynnig gwasanaethau i gefnogi ymddiriedolwyr, gan gynnwys:

- Ymateb i 500 a mwy o ymholiadau gan ymddiriedolwyr.
- Datblygu'r wefan ymddiriedolwyr, gan ddenu dros 30,000 o ymwelwyr, a dros 35,000 yn llwytho gwybodaeth oddi am.
- Trefnu cynhadledd genedlaethol ar gyfer ymddiriedolwyr gan ddenu dros 110 o gyfranwyr.
- Trefnu cynhadledd ar gyfraith elusennol gan ddenu dros 90 o gyfranwyr.
- Darparu e-fwletin misol ar gyfer ymddiriedolwyr unigol, gyda dros 580 yn ei dderbyn.

Cyllid

- Ymateb i dros 3,400 o ymholiadau am gyllid drwy'r llinell gymorth, a darparu cyngor manylach i dros 280 o fudiadau ynghyllch cyllid Ewropeidd a mathau eraill o gyllid.
- Cynnal gwefan Cyllid Cynaliadwy Cymru – www.sustainablefundingcymru.org.uk – mae'r wefan hon yn dal yn adnodd poblogaidd ar gyfer cael gwybodaeth am ddewisiadau cyllido a chyllid, gan ddenu dros 36,000 o ymwelwyr.
- Ar y cyd â chyngorau gwirfoddol sirol, datblygu cyfres o 35 o daflennoedd gwybodaeth am gyllid; ymddangosodd chwech o'r gyfres o daflennoedd gwybodaeth 'Dod o hyd i arian a'i gael' ymysg 10 uchaf y taflenni a lwythwyd

sheets downloaded across the infrastructure, with over 30,000 downloads from CVC and WCVA's websites.

- Developing a sustainable funding training programme consisting of an Introduction to Sustainable Funding, a series of six full-day follow-up training courses on core funding and finance strategies and a one-day course for funding advisors and development workers. This training was produced and delivered by WCVA staff for the third sector and cascaded by the CVCs into local communities.
- Running a small grants scheme, the 'Be informed' fund to encourage organisations to visit others to learn about sustainable funding.
- Securing support and technical assistance for a third sector Spatial European Team (3-SET) to advise organisations on European Structural Funds.
- Organising the Wales third sector funding conference.
- Providing a monthly funding e-bulletin, *Funding news*, to over 1,600 recipients.
- Responding to funding consultations on dormant accounts, Big Lottery Fund future programmes, WAG's Single Equalities Fund, Community Facilities and Activities Programme, Grassroots Fund and Post Office Development Fund.
- Responding to WAG's action plan on the Communities and Culture Committee report and commissioned to implement

WCVA organised the *Tough times: management and funding challenges in – and beyond – the recession* conference featuring presentations from the WLGA (pictured), the Welsh Assembly Government and WEFO.

- Providing a tax effective giving advice service.

Sustainable Funding Cymru training has enabled individuals and organisations to change their approach to funding and become more sustainable as a result.

A training participant said: 'I now feel more confident about the options available regarding sustainable funding'.

Over 80 per cent of all participants expressing a view indicated that they would recommend the course to another person.

Sustainable Funding Cymru has launched a new online resource - the Wales third sector funding portal - a one-stop shop for funding advice and opportunities which can be accessed by visiting www.sustainablefundingcymru.org.uk

The funding portal provides access to a searchable database of UK funding opportunities, advice and support on raising funds and tips on how to diversify funding.



- A successful research conference in October, where the Chief Social Research Officer for Wales spoke.
- In partnership with Swansea University, enabling over 50 patients, service users and carers to be involved in formulating, managing and disseminating health and social care research in Wales.

2 Promoting the sector's roles

WCVA has continued to support the sector to develop its different distinctive roles and contribution to major public policy initiatives.

Regeneration

- Providing a suite of community regeneration information sheets.
- Responding to over 2,000 enquiries to the Communities First Helpline
- Managing funding schemes to support community led regeneration, and providing:
 - over 1,000 grants totalling over £3m from the Communities First Trust Fund
 - loans totalling £816,000 and grants totalling over £248,000 from the Community Investment Fund
- Securing new contracts to provide advice and training under the Communities First programme.

Policy consultation and representation

- Maintaining up-to-date details of current policy issues and consultations at Wales, UK and European levels on WCVA's national website providing, attracting almost 50,000 visitors to the policy section who downloaded over 1,500 policy documents.
- Organising 16 regional policy events and other policy meetings, attracting over 1,300 participants, to discuss policy issues of interest to the sector.
- Publicising 208 policy consultations through the weekly consultation bulletin.
- Preparing 32 responses highlighting third sector interest and concerns.

The Voices for Change Cymru project was launched in May 2008 and aims to help to connect the third sector in Wales with local and national decision making. By providing a range of services to make campaigning and influencing easier the project will help the sector translate its wealth of frontline experience into effective campaigns and policy making.

To date the project has engaged with over 1,900 organisations and provides the following services to enable the sector to have its voice heard:

- A dedicated website (www.voicesforchangecymru.org.uk) complete with an Assembly monitoring service which details all Assembly business split into categories relevant to the sector.
- A series of training courses ranging from 'An introduction to Welsh politics' to 'Advanced campaigning and lobbying.' 12 courses were delivered in the 2008/09 period.
- A suite of 12 information sheets on a range of issues from local to national politics and how organisations can campaign and influence effectively.
- Our Voices database which has over 1,500 members who have signed up to receive information about opportunities to influence that are relevant to the areas they work in.
- A series of policy events about how to engage with UK and Welsh political structures.

The project has also worked with organisations on a one-to-one basis to provide training or advice.

Environment Wales has continued to be one of the largest supporters of voluntary and community based environmental action in Wales, also helping to deliver the Welsh Assembly Government, WCVA and its core partners' sustainable development agendas.

During this time Environment Wales has registered an additional 35 groups and awarded 131 grants in the 2008/09 period. The initiative has continued to maintain a high profile at national and regional events, acting as a signpost to its own support and to others committed to voluntary environmental action.

Working in partnership, helping expand and unite the varied remits of its core partners, ensures that the initiative can support environmental voluntary action in a dynamic way. Through the broad range of expertise and the wide-ranging remit of its development officers, Environment Wales is uniquely placed to meet the substantial needs of the sector.

Environment Wales Development Officers have helped ensure that the initiative has exceeded all of its targets by 80 per cent, creating 28 new posts. Most impressively Environment Wales is set to better or meet most in the next period.





Incoming Resources (Unrestricted funds)









WCVA started life in 1934 as the South Wales and Monmouthshire Council of Social Services. In its annual report of 1936-37 it highlighted the work of the Council with the Libraries of Workmen's Institutes and the Public Libraries of the Valleys.

It was reported that many of the libraries had not been able to afford new books since 1927 and that stocks were severely depleted and were out of date. A grant of £10,000 was sanctioned by the Commissioner for Special Areas and the Council administered this grant over a number of months. According to the report: 'few services that the Council has been able to render have met with a quicker and more genuine response from the beneficiaries.'

Adroddwyd nad oedd llawer o'r llyfrgelloedd wedi gallu ffondlio llyfrau newydd ers 1927 a bed stociau wedi'u disbyddiu ac yn hen. Yn ôl yr adroddiad: 'ychydig iawn o wasanaethau mae'r Cyngor wedi gallu eu cyllwyno sydd wedi dirbymateb cynllac ac mae diamaneuol gan buddiolwyr. Mae'r holl ardal yn ddiolchgar dros ben yr Comisiynydd am y griant amserol hwn.'
